**Brief Outline of the Lecture:** Through dynamic questions and discussions, Prof. James Kenneth Pong is going to impact to the audience the general landscape of the legal system of Hong Kong, which includes the court structure, differences between civil and criminal law, and the various legislations in relation to the environmental protection in Hong Kong. Examples drawing from interesting legal precedents, like the cases on the Hong Kong-Zhuhai-Macau Bridge and the Central Harbour Reclamation, will be used to demonstrate the various legal principles involved. The aim of this lecture is to arouse the interest of the students in familiarizing the various legal mechanisms in protecting the environment of Hong Kong.
